## From the Director's Desk

February is over now! We're still paying our bills but March is not looking as strong as January and February. Don't forget to send in your monthly gifts/donations.

### **All-Day Summer Program**

The Clubhouse for Special Needs had 22 young people throughout the summer program in 2008. As of right now we have added 3 more to that number. Remember, our building only holds 20 people and that includes staff. There WILL be a space problem this summer unless we move to a larger facility.

### **Expansion Plan**

We are working very hard on raising \$120k before June 1<sup>st</sup>. That is one year's budget when we move to a larger facility.

We sent out Letters of Inquiry and grant proposals to over twenty organizations/foundations hoping to raise \$120K. It is imperative that we have one year's budget in the bank before stepping out to a larger facility.

It is projected that in one year after our move we should have enough young people throughout our programs to make us financially self-sustaining.

### **YOU CAN HELP!**

Let's all spread the word about our plan to move to a larger facility [with a gymnasium] and see that move happen by raising \$120K by June 1<sup>st</sup>.
